

The COPPER PALETTE

Paint and Party

Home Studio Instructions

Materials Needed:

Just the kit!

Step 1

Dip the moist wipe into the background color and wipe on your backing board. Wipe in long strokes with the grain of the wood, wipe off any excess paint, and let dry. **Remember two or three thin coats are better than one coat with too much paint!**

Step 2

Grab the 3D design pieces - Pick a paint color to start with. Grab a sponge wedge and gently dab the flat side of the wedge in the paint. Now dab on the paper plate so you have very little paint on the sponge. Tip: You shouldn't see any bubbles on the painting wedge. Using a dabbing motion, start dabbing onto the design pieces, being careful to not get paint on the edges. Repeat for all the shapes and set aside to dry.

Step 3

Grab your backing piece. Apply a second coat if you think it is needed. Continue by putting second coats on your design pieces as well with the white wedges.

Step 4

Once everything is dry, place all your pieces where you would like them on your background. Start to peel off the backing of each piece, like a sticker, press onto the backing, and hold down for about 5 seconds.

Step 5

Display your sign leaning on a shelf or use command strips to display on a wall. Great job!

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
